Instructions for Registration with IDFPR

- Download and <u>print</u> the Registration Form found on the ISA Website under "Legislation" or by clicking this link: <u>https://idfpr.illinois.gov/profs/surgtech.html</u> and then clicking "Surgical Technologist - Acceptance of Examination and Endorsement"
- 2. You will be registering with the state of Illinois by "Acceptance of Examination". Follow the directions for "Acceptance of Examination". Complete the 4-page Application for Licensure/Examination in its entirety. (NOTE: There is language regarding licensure because this document is used for multiple professions. We will be "registered" not licensed. "Endorsement" is for those who have been or are currently registered/licensed in another state and are applying for registration in Illinois).
- 3. **Fill out the top portion of the AFF-ST form**, then scan and email NBSTSA a copy of the AFF-ST form. In your email, please ask them to complete the form and mail it to your address in a secure envelope that has not been opened. You will mail this form to IDFPR in the envelope you received it in. (NOTE: The language on the form still has LCC-ST as the governing body but this is now NBSTSA)
- 4. Complete the **CCA form**.
- Write a check or money order for \$100 to: Department of Financial and Professional Regulation
- 6. Once NBSTSA mails you the AFF-ST form in a sealed envelope, place the Application for Licensure/Examination, CCA form and unbroken envelope the AFF-ST form came in, and a check or money order for \$100 in a large envelope and mail to the following address:
